To benefit Sweet Arrow Lake County Park



Your seedlings will increase property value, enhance wildlife habitat, beautify the landscape, improve the environment, and can provide a source of income. *Thanks for your support of the lake!*

- **EASTERN WHITE PINE:** Great ornamental or Christmas tree with soft, long blue-green needles. Excellent for wildlife cover. Likes ordinary soil, average moisture, and full sun. 2 year old seedlings. Size: 2-4"
- **NORWAY SPRUCE:** Fastest growing of all spruces. Develops pyramidal shape and strong graceful branches that are covered with dark green needles. Ideal windbreaker that likes full sun and grows in various soils. Matures at 60 feet and has a beautiful 25 foot spread. 2 year old seedlings. Size: 4-8"
- **WHITE FLOWERING DOGWOOD:** Prolific, large, pure white, overlapping petal-like blooms in spring, dark green foliage in summer, red-purple leaves in fall and glossy red berries that persist into winter make this a lovely ornamental tree for all seasons. It has a short trunk, horizontal branches, and a moderately globe-shaped crown. The dense branching provides shade and nesting sites, fruit and buds are a favorite with dozens of bird species, and the nectar and pollen attract butterflies. Dogwoods prefer acidic, moist, well drained sites with partial shade, but will take full sun. 1 year old seedlings. Size: 4-8"
- **WASHINGTON HAWTHORN:** Height 25 to 30 feet. Spread 20 to 25 feet. Clusters of small, single, white flowers in May to early June. Bright red fruit fall and winter. Its dense, twiggy branches cut down on road noise and light glare. Berries attract birds. Thorns are a deterrent from browsing deer. 1 year old seedlings. Size: 5-10"
- **SUGAR MAPLE:** A landscape standout! Medium to dark-green leaves turn a spectacular yellow, burnt orange or red in fall. Tolerates shade, likes a well-drained, moderately moist, fertile soil. Grows to 60' to 75', 40'-50' spread. Future generations will thank you as they pour delicious home-made syrup tapped from your trees onto pancakes! 2 year old seedlings. Size: 4-8"
- **SWAMP WHITE OAK:** Grows to 50 to 60 feet in height and spread. Does well in wet, swampy conditions along rivers and streams. Excellent choice for wetland plantings. 2 year old seedlings. Size: 10-18"
- **RED OAK:** Very popular landscaping tree for shade on lawns, parks and golf courses. This oak is fast-growing and easy to transplant. It is tolerant of urban conditions including dry and acidic soil and has abundant acorns that attract wildlife. Leaves turn a brilliant brick-red fall color and adds color to a forest. This tree has been used in mine reclamation sites for revegetation purposes. 1 year old seedlings. Size: 6-12"
- **WHITE OAK:** Grows 50 to 80 feet in height and crown width. Grows best in a deep, loamy, well drained soil. The most prolific lumber oak in the Northern Hemisphere. A good tolerance of highway salt. Wetland species. 2 year old seedlings. Size: 10-20"
- **EASTERN RED CEDAR:** Pyramidal evergreen growing up to 50 feet. Medium green needles are flat and scale-like. Grayish to reddish brown bark is considered part of its ornamental interest. 2 year old seedlings. Size: 6-12"
- **BLACK CHOKEBERRY:** A deciduous shrub that features white flowers, black fruits and bold red fall foliage. Can be planted in either full sun or partial shade. You will get the best flowering and fruiting in full sun locations. The fruit can be canned whole or the juice extracted for jelly making as well as a healthful fruit drink. 2 year old seedlings. Size: 6-12"
- **SILKY DOGWOOD:** Deciduous spreading shrub. Multi-stemmed shrub with dense foliage and rounded form. New stems are reddish purple with fine silky hair. Flexible stems will root where they are in contact with the ground. Clusters of small white flowers in spring, followed by blue berries which ripen to black. Flowers attract butterflies. Fruit eaten by many birds. Leaves and twigs browsed by deer and rabbits. One of the more shade tolerant shrubs for moist soil. Used for restoration and ground stabilization because of its ability to readily root from stems. 5 year old seedlings. Size: 15-30"
- **ELDERBERRY:** Vigorous fast growing shrub to 10 feet in height. Spread 6 to 8 feet. Needs plenty of room to grow and is not considered a landscaping plant. Hosts clusters of bluish-black berries in late summer. Used for making jelly, preserves and wine. They are also a food source for wildlife and grows in various soils. Wetland tolerant. 2 year old seedlings. Size: 5-10"
- **CRANBERRY VIBURNUM:** A deciduous shrub, growing 8 to 12 feet with a spread to 8 to 12 feet. White flowers in clusters in May. Bright red berries early September through fall into February, which provide food for birds. People used to make jelly from the berries. Use as a screen or a background plant, space 4 feet apart. A good wetland plant. 2 year old seedlings. Size: 1-2 ft
