Your seedlings will increase property value, enhance wildlife habitat, beautify the landscape, improve the environment, and can provide a source of income. *Thanks for your support of the lake!*

- **EASTERN WHITE PINE:** Great ornamental or Christmas tree with soft, long blue-green needles. Excellent for wildlife cover. Likes ordinary soil, average moisture, and full sun. 3 year old seedlings. Size: 5-10"
- NORWAY SPRUCE: Fastest growing of all spruces. Develops pyramidal shape and strong graceful branches that are covered
 with dark green needles. Ideal windbreaker that likes full sun and grows in various soils. Matures at 60 feet and has a beautiful
 25 foot spread. 2 year old seedlings. Size: 5-10"
- RED MAPLE: This maple grows at a moderate to rapid rate and does best in bright sun to partial shade. It will grow in a range of soil types from sandy loam to clay. Better soil will result in a better healthier tree. The tree has a pyramidal shape when young. When the tree matures it will attain a larger more rounded crown and will grow to a size of 40-60 feet with a width of 25-45 feet. Leaves turn a brilliant red during fall and accent any yard. 5 year old seedlings. Size: 1-2'
- **REDBUD:** Redbud grows as a small tree with an abundance of purple blossoms in the spring. It has large heart-shaped leaves during the summer, and long seed pods in the fall. Popular landscaping tree. 3 year old seedlings. Size: 15-30"
- **RED OAK:** Very popular landscaping tree for shade on lawns, parks and golf courses. This oak is fast growing and easy to transplant. It is tolerant of urban conditions including dry and acidic soil and has abundant acorns that attract wildlife. Leaves turn a brilliant brick-red fall color and adds color to a forest. This tree has been used in mine reclamation sites for revegetation purposes. 2 year old seedlings. Size: 8-16"
- WHITE OAK: Grows 50 to 80 feet in height and crown width. Grows best in a deep, loamy, well drained soil. The most prolific lumber oak in the Northern Hemisphere. A good tolerance of highway salt. Wetland species. 2 year old seedlings. Size: 6-12"
- CHESTNUT OAK: A long-lived, deciduous tree that is a great choice as a shade tree for your front yard, or in a place where soil is unsuitable for most other trees. You can use it in the rocky, unpalatable locations of your yard and still expect success. It is decorative, great for wildlife and has a variety of uses. 2 year old seedlings. Size: 8-16"
- SUGAR MAPLE: A landscape standout! Medium to dark-green leaves turn a spectacular yellow, burnt orange or red in fall.
 Tolerates shade, likes a well-drained, moderately moist, fertile soil. Grows to 60' to 75', 40'-50' spread. Future generations will thank you as they pour delicious home-made syrup tapped from your trees onto pancakes! 3 year old seedlings. Size: 8-16"
- RIVER BIRCH: Open pyramidal growth to 90 feet. Fall color is yellow. The bark is variable, usually dark gray-brown and scaly, but can be smooth and creamy pinkish-white exfoliating in curly papery sheets. This paper thin bark peels in the winter. An excellent tree for low, swampy areas. 3 year old seedlings. Size: 10-20"
- BLACK CHOKEBERRY: A deciduous shrub that features white flowers, black fruits and bold red fall foliage. Can be planted in
 either full sun or partial shade. You will get the best flowering and fruiting in full sun locations. The fruit can be canned whole or
 the juice extracted for jelly making as well as a healthful fruit drink. 3 year old seedlings. Size: 8-16"
- BAYBERRY: Lustrous, deep green foliage is semi-evergreen. Very aromatic when crushed. A very ornamental shrub, growing 5 to 12 feet in height and spread. Noted for its waxy-gray berries, fall and winter, from which candles are made. Grows in poor, sandy soil. 2 year old seedlings. Size: 3-6"
- SILKY DOGWOOD: Deciduous spreading shrub. Multi-stemmed shrub with dense foliage and rounded form. New stems are reddish purple with fine silky hair. Flexible stems will root where they are in contact with the ground. Clusters of small white flowers in spring, followed by blue berries which ripen to black. Flowers attract butterflies. Fruit eaten by many birds. Leaves and twigs browsed by deer and rabbits. One of the more shade tolerant shrubs for moist soil. Used for restoration and ground stabilization because of its ability to readily root from stems. 4 year old seedlings. Size: 8-16"
- AMERICAN CRANBERRY: Excellent deciduous shrub for screening up to 10 to 12 feet high. Grows to a width of 8 feet with
 very dense growth of up to 3 feet per year in full sun or part shade. This bush has showy white flowers in spring followed by red
 berries in fall and winter. Berries hang through mid winter making excellent bird feed. This shrub has very few insect problems
 and prefers good, well-drained soil. For best growth, provide supplemental water during dry periods. For a solid screen, plant
 bushes 2 to 3 feet apart. 3 year old seedlings. Size: 6-12"
